All GIS digital formats supplied, are created using Environmental Systems Research Institute (E.S.R.I.) ARC/INFO GIS software on either a Windows NT workstation running ARC/INFO version 7.2.1 Patch 2 or on an Alpha Station 500 running ARC/INFO version 7.0.3 and Digital's Open VMS Operating System software. Format compatibility is the user's responsibility.

GIS digital data is available via magnetic media (4mm DAT, 9-Track tape, 100mb zip disk, or diskette) at this time. The GIS/Mapping Department can also create digital plot files and plot GIS digital data in the form of a hardcopy plot onto paper media. **Data can be ordered over the phone, and must be followed by a written request.** Request will be accepted via FAX and E-mail along with conventional delivery services.
